### Key projects

#### **2006 - Setting Up Scheme** – Lets Go Global, Manchester

As part of the Setting up Scheme run by the Design Initiative, I have started a 2-year intensive residency at a local community production organisation as a media artist (in which I will be predominately working on video art, installation and interactive pieces). The scheme is designed to focus on developing my own artistic business as well as work together with Lets Go Global to achieve my goals.

#### **2006 - Whisper Residency** – Chinese Arts Centre, Manchester

This year I have been given the opportunity to do two Whisper residencies at the Chinese Arts Centre. These residencies have been pivotal to my practice by giving me the breathing room I've needed to develop my *Sock Bunnies* project which I designed and made an interactive website: [www.sockbunnies.com](http://www.sockbunnies.com). During my residency I always invited the public to enter the studio space and discuss their thoughts on my project. The work also involved digital photography, digital video and textiles.

#### **2006 - Workshops** – Manchester

I am working within family learning to encourage parents and children to work together on art projects. I am responsible for planning workshop content, preparing materials & handouts as well as leading the workshops. I have been predominately working with Chinese communities where

English may not be their first language. I enjoy working with the families and really look forward to doing more.

**2006 - PAD scheme** – Chinese Arts Centre, Manchester

PAD scheme was set up for Chinese Artists that wanted to start devolving their artistic practice in the creative industries. It is a fantastic opportunity for me to meet and work with people at a similar stage to me. The PAD scheme is vital to my career since leaving University through support from the Chinese Arts Centre and fellow peers. The scheme has shown me to push myself to try things I may never have had the confidence to try before.

**2004 - Self-portrait UK** – Media 19 and National Portrait, National touring exhibition

Self-portrait UK was an open national competition in which I was one of the winners. Through this competition and more recently Self-Portrait UK Refugee, I have been behind the scenes of how events and exhibitions are organised. It was the first time that I had done large public talks and interviews for press about my work.

**2003 - The Lowry Theatre Volunteer** – The Lowry Theatre, Salford

I decided to volunteer while I was studying at university. I felt it was important to experience creative industries outside of academia. It very much opened my eyes to performance but more importantly working and talking with other energetic and vibrant creative people.
